The City of Beaverton is seeking sealed proposals from qualified consultants to provide federal government relations services and grant support on behalf of the City. Services may include providing counsel relative to governmental issues affecting the City, participating in regulatory and legislative processes on the City's behalf, federal grant support, and assessment of grant opportunities. Consultants are invited to submit a proposal outlining their experience and qualifications in performing work directly related to the services required.

Sealed proposals will be received until 2:00 pm on May 5, 2017 at City Hall located at The Beaverton Building, on the fourth floor, Finance Utility Billing Counter, 12725 SW Millikan Way, Beaverton, Oregon 97005, Attention Terry L. Muralt, CPPB, Purchasing Agent. There will be no formal opening. Facsimile proposals will not be accepted. Proposals will not be accepted after the stated opening date and time. Late proposals will be returned to the vendor unopened.

Proposers are required to certify non-discrimination in employment practices in accordance with ORS 279A.110(4), and identify resident status as defined in ORS 279A.120(1). Pre-qualification of proposer is not required. All proposers are required to comply with the provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes and Beaverton's Contract Review Board Policy.

The City of Beaverton reserves the right (1) to reject any or all proposal not in compliance with public bidding procedures, (2) to postpone award of the contract for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from date of proposal opening, (3) to waive informalities in the proposals, and (4) to select the proposal which appears to be in the best interest of the City.
