The City of Beaverton is seeking sealed proposals from qualified consultants to provide professional services related to architecture/urban design, landscape architecture, real estate market analysis, transportation and public engagement. Consultants are invited to submit a proposal outlining their experience and qualifications in performing work directly related to the services required.

A non-mandatory pre-proposal conference will be held in connection with this procurement at 10:00 AM on July 21, 2017 in the Council Chambers located at The Beaverton Building, 12725 SW Millikan Way, Beaverton, OR. Sealed proposals will be received until 2:00 p.m. on August 8, 2017, at The Beaverton Building, Finance Utility Billing Counter on the fourth floor at 12725 SW Millikan Way, Beaverton, Oregon 97005, Attention: Terry L. Muralt, CPPB, Purchasing Agent. There will be no formal opening. Facsimile proposals will not be accepted. Proposals will not be accepted after the stated opening date and time. Late proposals will be returned to the vendor unopened.

Proposers are required to certify non-discrimination in employment practices in accordance with ORS 279A.110(4), and identify resident status as defined in ORS 279A.120(1). Pre-qualification of proposer is not required. All proposers are required to comply with the provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes and Beaverton's Contract Review Board Policy.

The City of Beaverton reserves the right (1) to reject any or all proposal not in compliance with public bidding procedures, (2) to postpone award of the contract for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from date of proposal opening, (3) to waive informalities in the proposals, and (4) to select the proposal which appears to be in the best interest of the City.

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
