The Beaverton City Library, a department of the City of Beaverton, Oregon is accepting proposals from qualified library space planners to review library space usage and service points in public areas of the main library in order to improve the user experience, maximize utility of space, and mitigate crowding and congestion. The resulting recommendations must keep within a reasonable design and ambiance of the architecture.

Along with service point and space recommendations, the project should include estimated costs for the changes recommended, broken down by floor location and service area. The intent of this project is to develop workable solutions with which the library can prioritize and develop future budget requests and prepare grant proposals. Project should be concluded by June 30, 2018

There will be no pre-proposal meeting for this project. However, you may go on your own to the Beaverton City Library – Main to look at the areas of concern (Section 2.1 (B)).
