



Farmington Road (Murray to Hocken)

About

Farmington Road, between Murray Boulevard and Hocken Avenue, is currently a four to five lane roadway that lacks bicycle facilities on both sides of the road and continuous pedestrian facilities along the south side of the road.

This project will make needed safety and traffic capacity improvements to Farmington Road, between Murray Boulevard and Hocken Avenue, for all modes of transportation.

Improvements include:

- Widening the roadway to five lanes (two travel lanes in each direction with a center turn lane)
- Continuous bicycle facilities
- Continuous pedestrian facilities
- Street lighting
- Realign 141st and 142nd Avenues

Current Activity - design

This project is in the final design phase. A project open house is scheduled to occur in January 2014.

Design for this project, which included an extensive Public Advisory Committee process, was completed in 2004 by the City of Beaverton. However, the project was postponed until a funding source was identified and approved. Design consultant, Harper Houf Peterson and Righellis (HHPR) is currently updating the final design.
