Good afternoon,

I am writing with regard to the above-referenced development applications, for which I understand the city is accepting public comment until the end of the day today. I understand the homeowner is requesting approval to divide a single-family lot into 3 lots and remove 18 trees to accommodate 3 single family homes on what was originally intended for one single family home. I am a homeowner and resident of the Murrayhill neighborhood in which this property is situated, and I have concerns regarding this proposal. One of the hallmarks of our neighborhood is that the homes are situated on larger lots, with significant space in front and behind, to give a sense of privacy and space away from neighboring properties. In addition, the neighborhood has been built and developed with attention toward preserving the wooded feel and not cutting down more trees than necessary to accommodate the homes being built. I believe that approval of the request to remove these trees and allowing exceptions to the setback requirements to accommodate the additional homes will degrade the character of the neighborhood, and will encourage others to do the same, thus further detracting from the beauty of our community. Therefore, I urge the city to decline to approve this application.
